

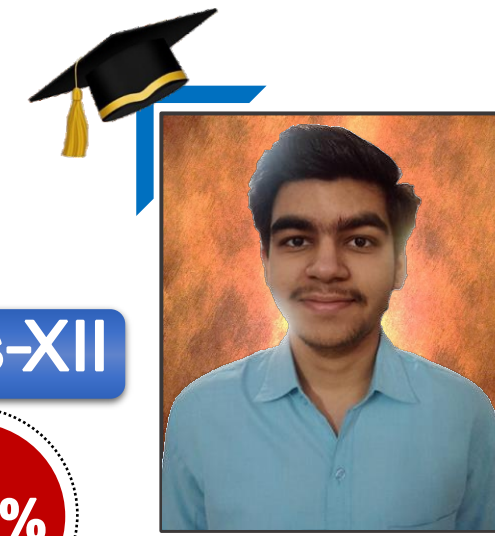

Skit Presented to Commemorate Martyrs' Day



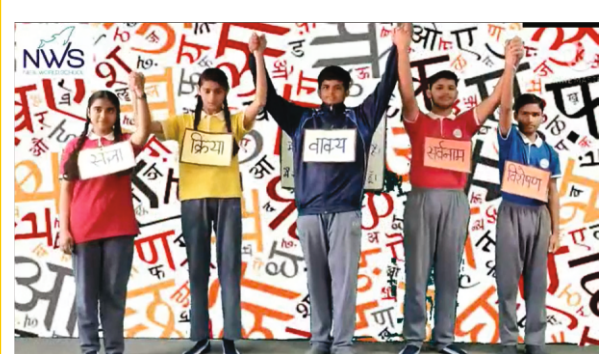
"They may kill me but they cannot kill my ideas. They can crush my body but they will not be able to crush my spirit." – Bhagat Singh
